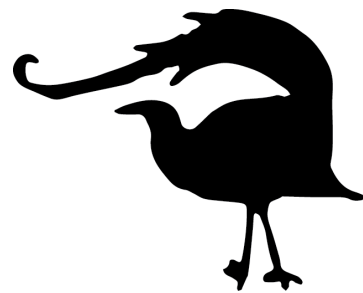


Woorilla Poetry Prize 2019

2019 WOORILLA ANNUAL POETRY PRIZE

Founded by Maria Millers and Louise Rockne and currently presented
in partnership with the Annual PAVE Festival in Emerald

CONDITIONS of ENTRY

- 1.0 Participants in the 12 - 18 year old age group are eligible to compete in the Woorilla Youth Section at no cost and without limits.
- 1.1 If desired, Youth entrants are also eligible to submit pieces for the Woorilla Open Section @ Open Section entry rates.
2. Poems should be composed in English and may be up to 50 lines per poem.
3. Poems submitted must be the entrant's own unpublished original work and not have won prior poetry prizes elsewhere.
4. Multiple entries are permissible.
5. Each poem, or set of poems should be accompanied by appropriate entry fee(s) (see www.woorilla.org.au).
- 6.0 Entries may be submitted in hard-copy format or lodged electronically (see www.woorilla.org.au).
- 6.1 Hard-copy entries should be printed as single-sided individual copies along with accompanying duplicates for each poem entered.
- 6.2 While typewritten / printed copies are preferred, legible hand written entries are acceptable.
- 6.3 Hard copy entries may be posted to Woorilla Poetry Prize, Care of Emerald Community House, 356 - 358 Belgrave-Gembrook Road, **Emerald** Vic 3782, or submitted in person at ECH during office hours). Note: Payment by cheque should be addressed to **Emerald Community House**.
- 7.0 All individual poems (including copies) must be free of information identifying the author.
- 7.1 Entrant's name and contact details plus listing of names of poems submitted are to be filled-out via pro-forma entry sheet provided.
8. Members of Emerald Community House are eligible to enter for the Woorilla Poetry Prize.
- 9 Copyright remains the domain of respective entrants. However organizers retain the right to publish prize-winning pieces on the PAVE & Woorilla websites and/or as a commemorative hard-copy compilation featuring respective award winners.
9. Woorilla organizers reserve the right to withhold awarding prizes in any given year in the event of insufficient entries, or due to lack of acceptable literary standards.
11. Adjudication of Woorilla Poetry Prize Judge(s) is final, and no correspondence will be entertained, following each annual poetry prize event
